Dear Parents,

As a part of our ministry's effort to encourage spiritual growth, each year we take a summer trip with the goal of fostering an environment that allows them to draw near to the Lord. Free from many of the regular distractions of life, it is during these trips that students often encounter the Lord in a meaningful and powerful way. Not only are lifelong memories created, but for many students, these are the weeks that they point back to that made a difference in their life. I would like to ask that you prayerfully consider allowing your child the opportunity to have this wonderful experience this summer.

For this year's trip we will be taking the students to Vision Kid's Camp held at Vision Retreat Center right here in Huntsville. We will be hosting this camp along with Hillwood Baptist Church here in Huntsville. The dates of the camp is July 9-11, 2018. This camp is for students who have completed 3rd - 6th grades. Our desire is for each student to experience the time of their lives and learn more about the message of Jesus Christ. This camp will include Bible lessons, recreation, and worship services.

COST / DEPOSIT

The cost of this camp is \$150, but we will have opportunities to raise some of the money through fundraisers. This cost includes camp and recreation fees, room, and all meals at camp. **There is a \$50 deposit (non-refundable) due by Wednesday, February 28th.** The deposit will put your child's name on the official list of those attending. After this date, there will be a \$20 late fee.

FUNDRAISERS

We will schedule fundraisers to help out with the balance. The first fundraiser will be our annual valentine banquet on Saturday, February 10th. Students will need to wear nice clothes and be at the church no later than 5:00 pm and will need to remain until the fundraiser is complete. They will help with set-up, some food preparation, waiting tables and clean-up. Students will need to have their own ride to and from church. The funds raised will be divided among those who participate (i.e. we raise \$1000 and 10 students helped out; \$100 will go to each student.) We hope that we will be able to raise all the funds needed through this one fundraiser, however if needed we will hold another and will get the information out to you.

BALANCE

The balance for any funds not raised (less the deposit) will be due by June 20th. Again, we don't want cost to be the reason for anyone not to go. So if there is a need for help, a parent/guardian needs to contact me before money is due and we will do what we can to work something out.
