

Centrifuge Camp 2021 | June 21-25

Please be in prayer for our students as they depart for a life-changing experience at Centrifuge Camps. Be in prayer for safe travel to-and-from camp, as well as that the students accept and



receive the movement of the Holy Spirit in their lives. We know that so many, if not every single person, here at Sherwood has had a hand in the sending of our students to this camp. We want you to know just a snippet of what will be going on at camp this year.

At Centrifuge, students are divided into groups for recreation and Bible study based on age ranges by grade completed

Recreation is facilitated within Bible study groups by a member of our trained FUGE camp staff, who also leads the Bible study. Each activity serves a specific purpose and is debriefed so students can make application in their lives.

Students also participate in Track Times. Track Times are created to give students the opportunity to participate in something with which they are familiar, or try something new! Students are divided into "tracks" based on a list of activities they indicate during the registration process. We offer creative, active, performance, and classroom-based activities during these times, and each track is led by a member of the FUGE staff.
